Presentation overview

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Moving Italianness aims to foster interactions and synergies between partner institutions in Italy and Argentina to create innovative transnational education programs on the topic of Heritage.

Universities in Italy and Argentina have developed strong and longlasting collaboration.

The project yearns to intensify internationalization between the two areas, through the joint planning and implementation of innovative academic programs.









Thanks to shared cultural roots also deriving from the significant presence of communities of Italian descent in Argentina, universities in Italy and Argentina have developed strong and longlasting collaborations engaging a wide set of actors and nourishing a legacy which spans over traditions and generations.









The objectives are:

- creating an inclusive and diverse mobility scheme for students and academic staff between Italy and Argentina;
- designing and delivering innovative joint second and third cycle programs involving partner universities;
- implementing a comprehensive framework of joint Advanced Skills Courses (ASCs);









Moving Italianness is funded by the PNRR (National Recovery and Resilience Plan), through the NextGenerationEU Fund.

The project is part of the Mission 4 - Education and Research:

- Component 1 Enhancement of the supply of education services: from kindergartens to universities
- Investment 3.4 Education and advanced university skills
- Sub-measure T4 "Transnational education initiatives" (TNE)









Total budget: 1.988.761,28€

Eligible costs:

- personnel fully dedicated to the project for coordination
- mobility for students and academic staff (professors and researchers)
- design of joint courses for students
- organization of advanced skill courses
- communication, dissemination and outreach activities

The budget can be managed only by Italian Universities









For the **incoming mobility** of this TNE project, the selected Professors/Researchers and Students/PhD Students will get their travel tickets provided by UNINA (through an agency).

In addition:

- For Professors/Researchers (with mobility of between 5 and 12 days)
 the agency will also provide an half-board accommodation;
- For Students/PhD Students, a scholarship of €1,000 per month (for two months) will be provided.










Project timeline








Mobility schemes

Steps for mobilities implementation Guidelines for incoming students

- 1. Collection of partner Universities' International Mobility Office emails and first contact with their staff.
- 2. Partners Universities will run student selections, through a fair and open procedure.
- UniNA will share with their partners the TNE graphic; this must be used for all documents.
- 4. UniNA will receive the list of participants and will interview them: these must be sent by September 24th, 2025.
- 5. Administrative Staff will contact selected students for application guidance.









Steps for mobilities implementation Guidelines for incoming professors

The partner University can select professors who will come to University of Naples Federico II according to its internal procedure.

After the selection process, it's necessary to send:

- The nomination letter to the UniNA scientific coordinator of the project (Prof. Carla Masi Doria, cmdoria@unina.it)
- The nomination letter + documentations to UniNA Administrative Staff email addresses (<u>zitacaterina.siniscalchi@unina.it</u> and <u>vincenzomigliore.web@gmail.com</u>)

UniNA will get in touch with the selected professors for clarifying the following steps.
